Josh Hisle Working On From War To Wisdom Documentary

Josh Hisle, singer songwriter and former U.S. Marine, will tell the unspoken story about soldiers at war in his new film 'From War To Wisdom'.

'From War To Wisdom' is currently in production with an expected release in 2015. The movie looks at the mental battle soldiers have during war and then again back in "the real world" after they return from service knowing what they now know.

Hisle says the film is not "anti-war or pro-war, it is a pro-soldier film".

The movie takes the viewer into the very centre of the wars in Iraq and Afghanistan with horrific but real footage and a sense of what a soldier has to prepare for mentally as well as physically for battle.

Josh Hisle and Daniel Collins are the Co-Directors of 'From War To Wisdom'.

Corporal Josh Hisle USMC is a two-tour combat veteran of the Iraq war. His side of the story was first told publicly in the Crosby, Stills, Nash & Young 2008 documentary 'Déjà vu'. After returning from war, Josh signed with Neil Young and Elliot Roberts' Vapor Records. He has released two albums 'Hearts and Minds' (2006) and 'Whiskey At Home' (2011).

The movie features combat veterans from the United States Marine Corps who served during the invasion and occupation of Iraq, many who fought alongside Hisle. USMC and Army veterans from Iraq, Afghanistan and Vietnam and their families will also appear in the film.

Josh and Dan are also composing the soundtrack for 'From War To Wisdom'. The first song is mine. "Mamma Don't Come Home". The second is Dan Collins "You Can't Go Home" and we plan to score all of it," Josh tells Noise11.com.
